



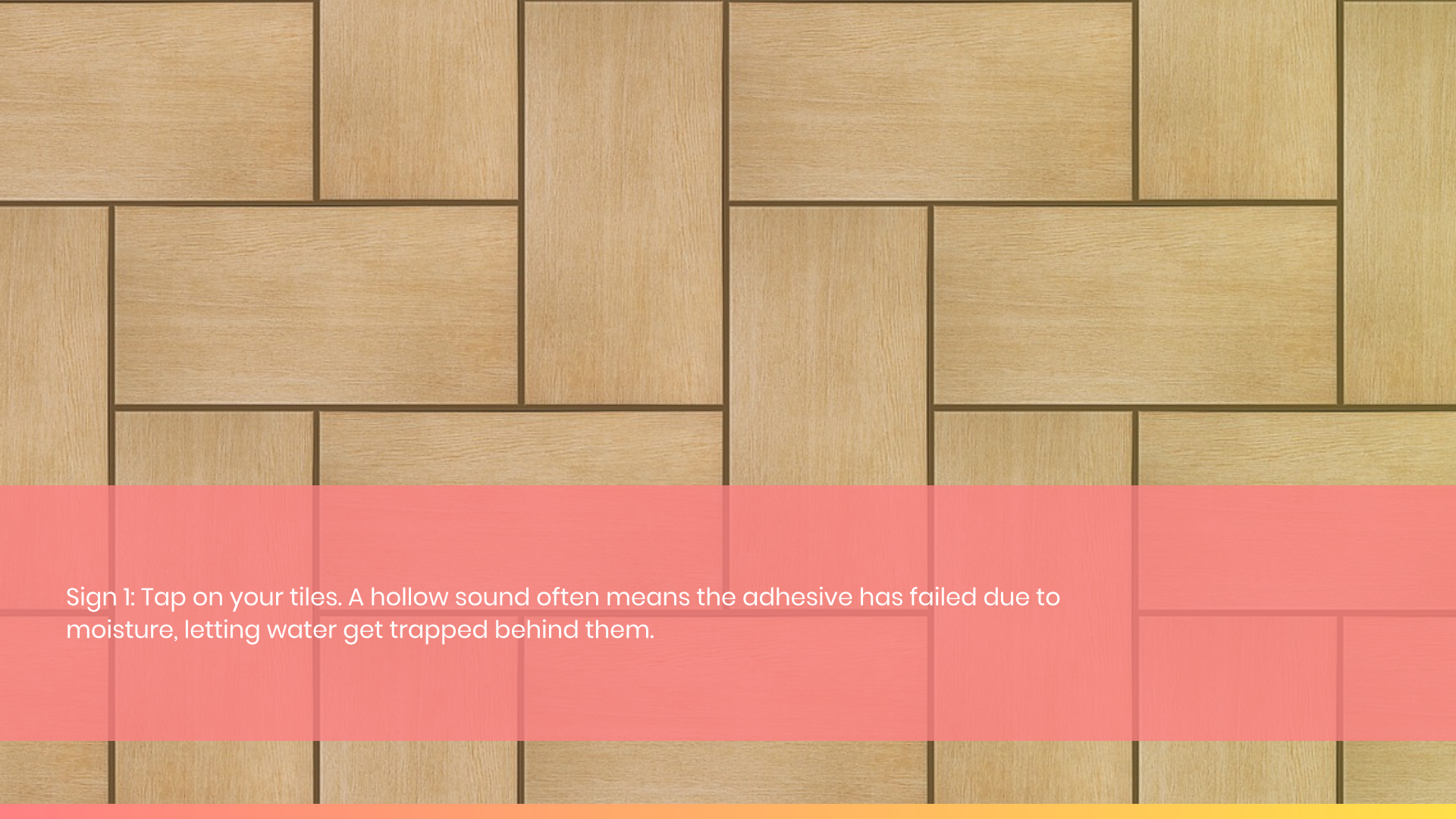
Water Damage Behind Shower Tiles | 4 Warning Signs to Spot



Did you know an estimated 75% of tiled showers eventually fail, allowing water to seep behind walls? This common problem often starts silently.



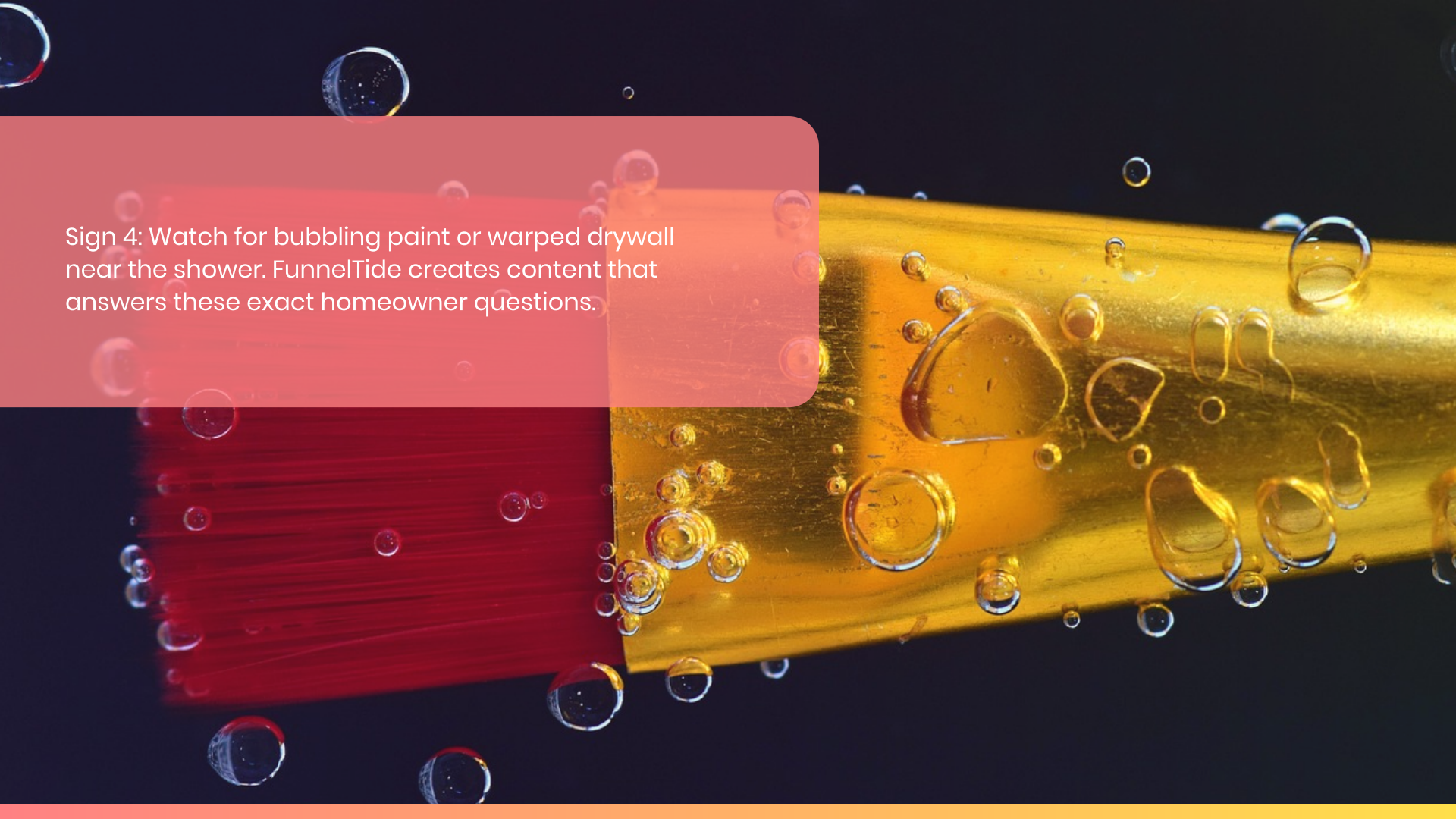
Small leaks can lead to repairs costing over \$2,500. Mold can also begin growing in just 24 to 48 hours, posing a hidden health risk.



Sign 1: Tap on your tiles. A hollow sound often means the adhesive has failed due to moisture, letting water get trapped behind them.



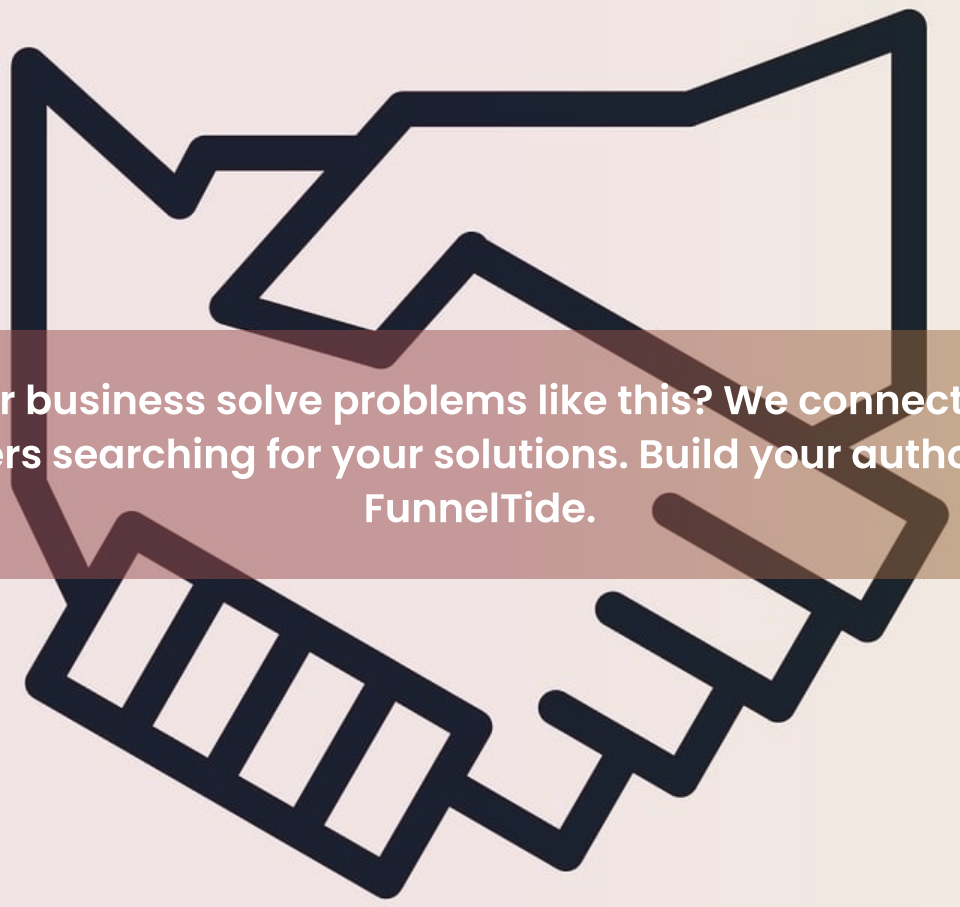
Signs 2 & 3: Look for stained, crumbling grout or a musty smell that won't go away. That odor is a key indicator of hidden mold growth.
